16786- APOLOGIES

16788- MINUTES

Resolved - that the Minutes of the Meeting of the Highways and Leisure Committee held on 25th July 2017, as now submitted, be signed by the Committee Chair.

16789- PEDESTRIANISATION ORDER – BRUNSWICK ROAD

The Committee received and considered a report from the Clerk, which enclosed a letter from Flintshire County Council with reference to a review of the pedestrianised zones in both Buckley and Holywell. The letter from Flintshire County Council sought the Town Council's position in relation to potentially de-pedestrianising the pedestrianised area

of Brunswick Road. The letter from Flintshire County Council stated “Should the Town Council support this change Flintshire County Council can then progress the scheme to a detailed design and formal consultation stage”.

Following a detailed debate it was –

Resolved – that the Town Council was not in a position to give either its support or objection to the County Council’s intended review as it was not in possession of any detailed design statement, costings or detailed risk assessments. The Clerk was therefore instructed to convey the Town Council’s position to Flintshire County Council and request a detailed design statement, costings and risk assessments for its consideration.
